## Re: UCT COMMENTS ON MYSTERIOUS DEATH OF STUDENT

Good day,

Your article titled "UCT COMMENTS ON MYSTERIOUS DEATH OF STUDENT" refers.

The opening is grossly inaccurate. The para states:

*Cape Town – The University of Cape Town (UCT) has commented on the death of a UCT student who was believed to have been missing by his family. Siboniso Dlamini, a 25 year old, business science was attacked off campus by a person familiar to him, said UCT spokesperson Elijah Moholola.*

This is incorrect. As stated, circumstances around Mr Dlamini's death are being investigated by the SAPS. The only reference to "a person familiar to him" in our statement was the woman who was visiting Dlamini, with whom he had an altercation. The altercation with the visiting person and the discovery of Mr Dlamini's body are not linked – something which the introductory para of this story incorrectly does.

Can you urgently correct this story please and make a note that the earlier inaccuracy was corrected? We are particularly concerned about the potential legal implications of this incorrect reporting and the impact that this could have on his family.
