ABSTRACT

The 2016 Community Survey, a large-scale survey run by Statistics SA of over 3.3m people in the country, collected data on women's recent and lifetime fertility, allowing the estimation of fertility rates in the country in 2015.

This seminar presents the analysis of recent trends in fertility nationally, by population group, and by province. The seminar will reflect on what these trends imply for the past and future course of fertility change in the country.

The data also allow us to gain some insights into the completeness of recent reporting of births in the country.
