

ERASMUS MUNDUS scholarship opportunities for University of Cape Town Masters and Doctoral students, Academic and PASS staff

Grant contracts for 2012 were awarded to two partnerships of South African and European higher education institutions (HEIs), i.e. the **EMA2SA** and the **EUROSA** partnerships. The grant contracts will be used to award scholarships to and arrange mobility for South African masters and doctoral students and HEI staff to European HEIs for study, research or teaching in a wide range of disciplines.

1. EMA2SA (Action 2 – Erasmus Mundus Partnerships)

The University of Cape Town is a member of this consortium and UCT staff and students can apply for these scholarships as **Target Group 1 candidates**. Applications for scholarships have been opened by EMA2SA at <http://www.ema2sa.eu/index.php>. The deadline for applications is **16 March 2012**.

2. EUROSA (Europe and South Africa Erasmus Mundus Partnership for Human Development)

The University of Cape Town is not a member of this consortium, however, masters and doctoral students from UCT may apply for scholarships as **Target Group 2 candidates**. UCT academic and PASS staff **cannot** apply for EUROSA scholarships. Applications for scholarships have been opened by EUROSA at www.ua.ac.be/eurosa. The application deadline is **12 March 2012**.

ERASMUS MUNDUS Information Session @ UCT in 2012

EMA2SA and EUROSA representatives will visit the University of Cape Town on **Tuesday 28 February 2012 at 10.00 AM** to meet with prospective applicants and answer questions. The structure of the info session will start with a presentation to introduce the Erasmus Mundus Scholarship Programmes and the study opportunities at the EMA2SA and EUROSA partner universities. The presentation will be followed by a practical session where the representatives will guide potential applicants through their online application. The session will be for approximately 1,5 hours (30 to 45 minutes for the presentation + Q&A and 30 to 45 minutes for the practical session). The venue will be confirmed in early 2012 and posters will be placed around campus with all the details.
