



ASSISTANT LECTURER: EMERGENCY MEDICINE

(Full-time, two-year position)

The Division of Emergency Medicine seeks to appoint an Assistant Lecturer to assist with teaching and research across the divisional programs. This is a full-time, two year position, potentially renewable. Responsibilities include teaching across all programs, assisting with the administration of programs, mentoring of post-graduate students in the division, and assisting the Division to improve research outputs. This position will require onsite teaching in the Faculty of Health Sciences.

Requirements include:

- Undergraduate clinical degree, registerable with HPCSA or SANC
- Master's degree in either clinical emergency care or public health or similar
- Demonstrable experience in clinical emergency care
- Demonstrable teaching experience, including minimum 3 years in the healthcare sector
- Proven experience in carrying out core research tasks (such as literature reviews, scoping of funding opportunities, writing and revising research protocols, and scientific writing)
- Teaching experience in tertiary level health education
- Ability to teach advanced life support skills
- Strong computer skills (Word, Excel, e-mail and calendar programs, PowerPoint, etc.)
- Excellent interpersonal abilities
- Excellent written and verbal communication

Advantageous:

- Experience in teaching clinical emergency skills and simulation
- Expertise in online teaching and teaching with technology
- Demonstrable history of scientific publications
- Demonstrable experience in post-graduate supervision

Responsibilities include:

- Assist in teaching and co-ordination of allocated courses on PG Dip and MPhil programs
- Assist and co-ordinate undergraduate teaching of resuscitation skills to MBChB students
- Assist with online teaching platform development and migration
- Liaison with faculty to ensure smooth administration of allocated topics, courses and programs and appropriate progression of students
- Mentoring (including research supervision and co-supervision) of post-graduate students in the Division of Emergency Medicine
- Assisting the Division to improve Research outputs including conducting own research.
