- **Justice and Reconciliation in Rwanda: Successes and Challenges by Chief Justice Sam Rugege** – The Faculty of Law in collaboration with the International Academic Programmes Office presents a Public Lecture, organised as part of IAPO's 20th Internationalisation Anniversary, by Chief Justice Professor Sam Rugege of the Supreme Court of Rwanda.
- **From Differentiated Responsibilities to Climate Apartheid: Climate change communication in Africa by Ian-Malcolm Rijdsdijk** - Climate justice has increasingly become a major theme of the annual COP gatherings, to the extent that the South African delegate, in advance of COP21 decried the proposed climate rescue pact as 'climate change apartheid'. Rijdsdijk asks: how could a process premised on nations of the world meeting to arrest a growing catastrophe be characterised by an analogy with one of the most repressive political regimes of the 20th century? What was the origin of this redeployment of the term? What African cultural and philosophical perspectives can contribute to the problem of climate change and our adaptations to changing physical environments?
- **Book launch of 'The Equal Society'** – UCT's Poverty and Inequality Initiative presents 'The Equal Society,' edited by George Hull – 14 new philosophical essays by international scholars on social equality, epistemic justice, relative poverty, race, gender equality, African philosophy and more. Speakers: Dr George Hull and Professor Crain Soudien.
- **17th Annual GSB Women in Business Conference** - The annual WIB Conference celebrates the achievements of businesswomen in South Africa who have made, and continue to make, a distinguished contribution to our society. The primary goal of the conference is to raise funds to support deserving, but financially disadvantaged, women seeking to enrol in Open Academic Programmes at the Graduate School of Business (GSB). The speaker line-up includes Cherie Keating (MD of Dermalogica) and Gabi Lowe (crusader for the Jenna Lowe Trust). The keynote speaker is Zukie Siyotula, WEF Young Global Leader and former Divisional CEO of a leading investment company.
