## Re: Court rules challenge over WSU's LLB accreditation not urgent

Good day,

Your article titled "Court rules challenge over WSU's LLB accreditation not urgent" (18 January 2018) refers.

The article incorrectly states that UCT is among the institutions that "had been informed that their accreditation would be withdrawn."

When the Council on Higher Education (CHE) made the announcement last November, there were four categories, including those whose accreditation had been withdrawn and those served with notice of withdrawal if they did not respond to the issues raised by the CHE in its findings. UCT's LLB was categorised under notice of withdrawal.

UCT has been given until May 2018 to respond to the CHE's findings and submit a revised improvement plan, based on which the CHE will decide the accreditation status of the UCT Law degree.

The university is confident that it will respond to the CHE's concerns and continue to offer its LLB programme to students who are widely recognised as excellent graduates.
