About the Funding Opportunity

The NIHR Global Health Research portfolio funds applied health research in areas of unmet need for the direct and primary benefit of people in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs). Recognising a gap in the global health funding landscape for mid-career researchers, particularly for researchers employed in LMICs, the NIHR is launching a new Global Advanced Fellowship scheme.

The NIHR Global Advanced Fellowship awards support postdoctoral researchers in LMICs and the UK working in applied global health research. The Fellowship is aimed at individuals at various points of their career. The scheme is open to all health (clinical or non-clinical), public health and social care research and methodology professions.

- Hold a relevant PhD or postgraduate medical research degree or have submitted your thesis for examination at the time of application. You must have been awarded your PhD or postgraduate medical research degree by the time you attend interview.
- Not already hold a Professorship/Chair at the point of application.
- For clinical applications: have completed relevant pre-registration training.
- Be conducting research that directly and primarily benefit patients and the public in countries on the [OECD DAC list](#).
