

Open Call: NRF Travel Grant Applications

Please note that the online application for Scholarship- and Fellowship-Holders' Travel Grants is not ready on the system and therefore a manual application process will have to be followed.

The institutions (through the DAs) will submit eligible travel grant applications for scholarship- and fellowship-holders to the NRF three (3) times a year. Applicants must ensure that they submit applications to the institution before the institutions' internal closing date. No late applications will be accepted.

NB: The Masters and Doctoral grantholders (except NRF-Nuffic split side mode) awarded scholarships in 2021 and beyond, Honours scholarships, Collaborative Postgraduate Training, Professional Development Programme, and Extension Support are not eligible for the NRF travel grant.
