## Bursary Requirements and Eligibility

To be considered for a bursary in any of the above-mentioned fields, you will need to meet the following criteria:

- Must be a citizen or have permanent residency in South Africa
- Be enrolled or intending to enroll as a full- time student in a South African university
- Must have an overall average result of 65% at Grade 12
- Must maintain excellent tertiary results throughout his/her studies



## How to Apply

1. **Complete the Application Form** – this can be downloaded from the UCT Portal: Notices or from the Financial Aid Advisor at the Student Funding Centre
2. Submit completed forms to the **Student Funding Centre** together with the **following Documents**
  - Certified copy of your identity document
  - Latest copy of results/ academic transcripts
  - Certified copy of parents/guardian/spouse proof of income
  - Affidavit of unemployment of parent/guardian/spouse
